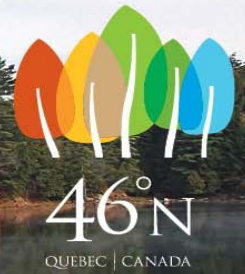

## Travelling by car from Montreal Airport to 46° North

Starting at P.E. Trudeau Airport in Montreal, follow all the signs that direct you to Mirabel Airport and/or the blue signs to Mont-Tremblant.

As you take the only exit from Trudeau airport, you will see a blue sign for "Mont-Tremblant"— follow it. Follow the signs for **Autoroute 520 East** also known as “Côte de Liesse”. After about 5km, the 520 will take you to **Autoroute 13 North**.

From Autoroute 13 take the exit for **Autoroute 640 East** . You will stay on the 640 for a couple of kilometres until you see the exit for **Autoroute 15 North**. Again, follow the Mirabel Airport or the Mont-Tremblant signs.

Once on the Autoroute 15 North, continue for about 45 minutes. After 65 km the 15 North turns into the **117 North** at Ste-Agathe-des-Monts: there is no exit, the four-lane road becomes two lanes. Simply continue on the same road.

Continue on the 117 North past the town of Mont-Tremblant (previously known as St-Jovite). You will drive through two sets of traffic lights on the main highway parallel to the town and pass several supermarkets (IGA, MAXI, SUPER C, CANADIEN TIRE) on the right hand side.

Keep heading north on the 117 for another 20 minutes through the town of **Labelle**. At the traffic lights turn **RIGHT** on RUE DU PONT. Keep straight after the bridge on CHEMIN DU MOULIN for just few meters (here you will see the blue sign directing you to 46°N resort) and turn left on the next street RUE GÉLINAS. Turn **RIGHT** on RUE ALLARD. Continue on Rue Alarie and at the STOP sign, turn **LEFT** onto **CHEMIN DU LAC-CACHÉ** (Portions unpaved).

Follow this road for 5km, where you will find our main **46° North entrance** at 10 Chemin Du Lac-Caché La Macaza, on your right hand side.
